



Interscholastic Activity (ISA) Community Service Requirement

Non-credit requirement

Course Numbers: 9th grade – 9020 / 10th grade – 9030
11th grade – 9040 / 12th grade – 9050

Pueblo City Schools ISA Requirement:

A minimum of 20 clock hours of activity, not related to academic/classroom credit, are required per school year for students enrolled in Pueblo City Schools (grades 9th through 12th). A school year will be defined as June 1st through May 1st.

Students are responsible for logging their hours, and students cannot receive payment for activity hours. Students should submit their completed ISA Form to the EHS Data Entry Secretary, who located in the counseling office. Please make sure that completed forms have all needed signatures.

What types of activities does Pueblo City Schools allow for this requirement?

- Participation in individual or team sport and physical activities within and outside of school may count as 20 clock hours of activity; however, this same activity cannot be used for both a PE credit and an ISA credit. The student must choose whether his or her participation in a sport will be used as an ISA credit or a PE credit.
- Participation in school clubs and organizations such as Key Club or NHS are acceptable activities
- Participation in service projects and volunteering in the surrounding community

Pueblo City Schools' ISA requirement is one that East is striving to make meaningful to our students, and even though the District's requirement is more aligned to Community Service expectations, East would like students to use this requirement to build Service Learning experiences.
